

HOMEWORK POLICY

The Board of School Trustees affirms the educational value of appropriate homework assignments. Such assignments provide learning activities that complement classroom instruction by reviewing, reinforcing, extending, or enriching the instruction provided during the class period. Appropriate homework assignments also promote effective, life-long study habits by encouraging the development of student responsibility and organization. Appropriate homework may include, but is not limited to, practice exercises, reading assignments, in-depth extensions of classroom activities, or independent projects related to the subject being taught. Since the homework policies are included in the student handbooks, the Board of School Trustees will review and approve the corresponding homework policy at the time student handbooks are reviewed and approved each year.
